### WHO ARE WE?

Old School Muay Thai has established a not-for-profit organization (Muay Thai Training Centres Inc) offering support to at-risk youth within the community through open access to the physical and mental benefits of quality martial arts practice. Our centrally located gym offers at-risk youth a place to meet after school, access to caring and supportive mentorship and a pathway to good health and self-realization.

We are already working in partnership with community organizations including the Harbourfront Community Centre to identify kids who can benefit from our programming. Other community partners include WoodGreen Community Services, Scadding Court Community Centre, The Remix Project, the City of Toronto's Recreation Partnership & Investment Program and Allied Properties.

### WHY DONATE TO OUR PROGRAM?

Your support and funding will allow at-risk youth to attend Old School Muay Thai community support program where they will have access to positive role models who, through martial arts programming, will inspire them toward personal fulfillment, physical health, and encourage integration into the community as citizens with respect for themselves and others.

Only 9.5 per cent of Toronto youth have access to after school programming. Lacking a structured environment to nurture skills and interests, at-risk youth resort to drugs, alcohol, violence and other delinquent behaviour to pass time.
